Preparing the engine control unit:

You are advised to seal your unit (*ref. 1*) to protect it against dampness and water that may splash up when driving through water or when cleaning with a high pressure hose.

Product to be used: Loctite 5368, or black auto-sealant.

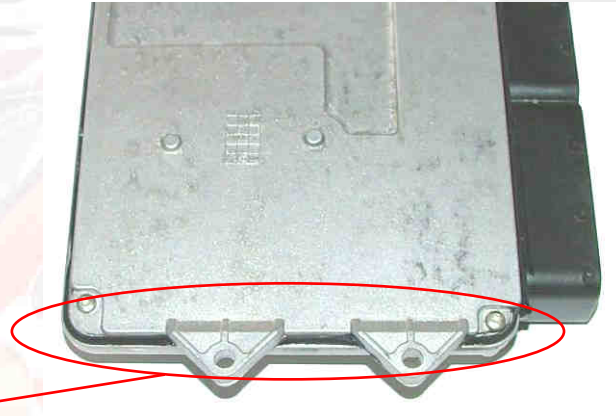
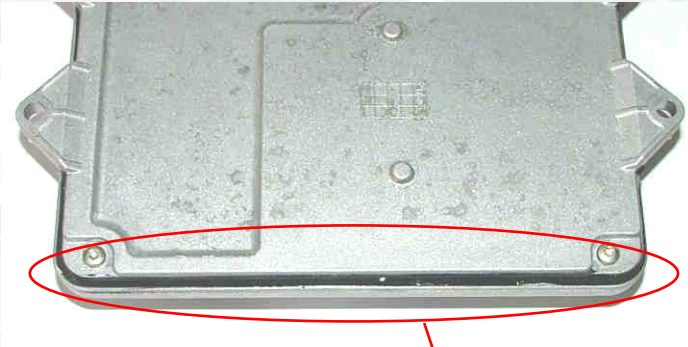
Sealing between the plastic "connector" area and the aluminium unit:

Sealing between the upper and lower units:



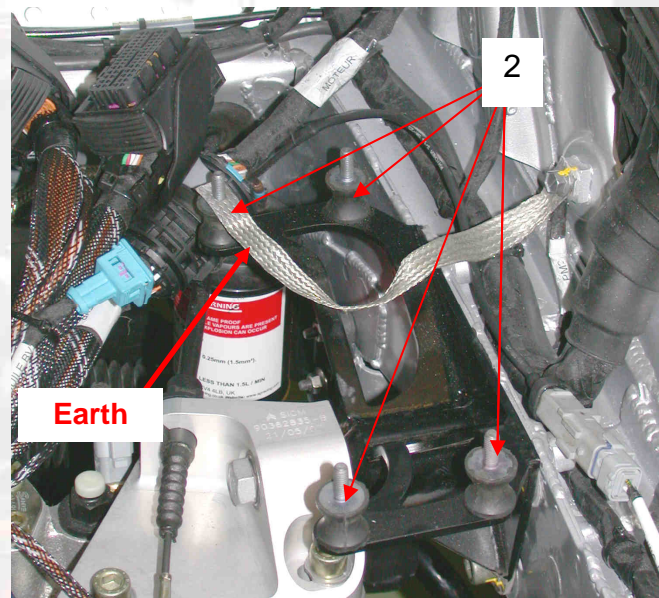
Sealant application area



Fitting the engine control unit:

Screw the silent-blocks (*ref. 2*) on the gear box mount.

Do not forget the earthing strap on a silent-block, to ensure that the engine control unit is properly earthed.

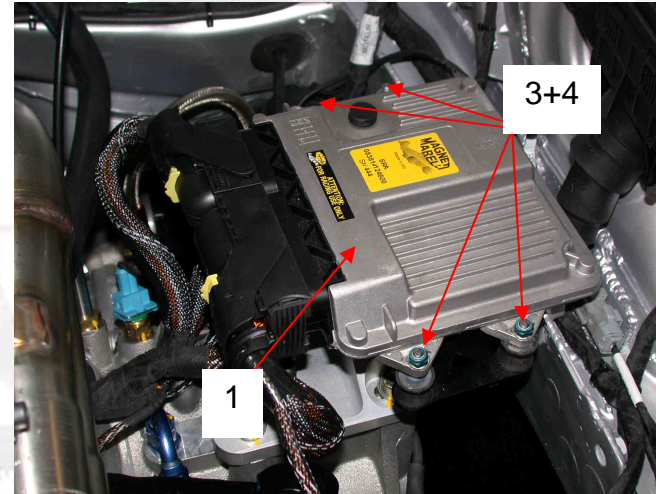

Fit the engine control unit ([ref.1](#)) on the silent-blocks, and tighten the M6 nuts ([ref.3](#)) with washers ([ref.4](#)).

Connect the unit to the engine bundle, using the two connectors.
